



Around the Green

Local Housing Needs Survey

Over 33% of Newton's households responded to the recent Local Housing Needs Survey. The survey responses are now being analysed in confidence by the Suffolk Rural Housing Enabler, Louise Wilby. Louise will be presenting her findings and recommendations at the next meeting of Newton Parish Council on the 9th January 2013. Once this is known the Parish Council, in conjunction with Babergh District Council, will consider what can be done to meet any need identified.

Lilleyfields

Babergh District Council's Development Committee gave personal permanent planning permission for Mr Street and his family to move to the paddock adjoining the outbuildings at Lilleyfields. The site will have to be returned to paddock should Mr & Mrs Street leave the site permanently.

The number of pitches is restricted to one (comprising of a mobile home, touring caravan and outbuilding) and the number of days that the site can be occupied by more than one touring caravan is restricted to 28 in any calendar year. BDC also included a provision that the applicant has to provide a financial contribution towards the public open space provision in the village.
