The committee feels that a good starting point is to identify all Grade I and II listed buildings in our parish and use this information to show how the village has expanded over time.

As major social hubs of the village the Golf Club and The Saracens Pub also form part of that history as well as local 'Buildings of Note' such as All Saints Church.




Forth Coming Activities
